Fire in the Field

Welcome to FIF 100!

What is this course about?

The material in this course covers the material presented in the National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) courses S-130, S-190, and I-100. The objectives are based on the task book for the position of Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2 PTB) as well as for Incident Commander Type 4 (ICT 4 PTB) in the National Interagency Incident Management System, as identified by the NWCG.

How long will it take?

FIF 100 is broken up into eight sessions that are approximately three hours in length. This timeframe, however, varies greatly from student to student.

If you feel comfortable combining sessions, do so. If you need more time to read and study session material, break up the course into smaller chunks to ensure you gain full understanding of the content.

You may use the articles and the video transcripts to complete the review quizzes and study guide questions.

How do I get help if I don't understand?

Contact your supervisor using the course messaging system if you have questions or comments about the course content.

Is there a test at the end?

The final sessions for the course involve taking the written NWCG final exam for the S-130, I-100, and S-190 courses. Use your study guide as a review before taking this exam.

You will also be required to complete the competencies in the FFT2 PTB during field training.

We also recommend that you revisit the material from this course after you have had experience in the field, as field context will help make this course more personally meaningful.
