

Directions for downloading the Maryland Forests Forever Patch on the PC:

This patch will correct two highlighting errors on the posttest.

Directions:

1. **INSTALL CD-ROM:** Be sure to install your Maryland Forests Forever CD-ROM before downloading the patch.
2. **DOWNLOAD PATCH:** Click the button labeled, "Download PC patch."
3. You will see a screen with the info, "You have chosen to download a file..." Click "Ok" to save this program to a disk.
4. The next screen will ask you where to save it. We suggest you save it to your desktop so it will be easy to find. Do not rename the file.
5. **UNZIP PATCH:** When it has been downloaded, double click the zipped file called, "mdffpatch" that will be located on your desktop (if that is where you saved it to). Click "unzip." When it has unzipped, click "ok." (Note: Click "yes" if it asks you if you want to replace the existing file named "POST.")

PC Note: In order for this patch to function correctly, it must be placed in the program files for the Maryland Forests Forever software. Be sure to install your Maryland Forests Forever CD-ROM first. Then download the patch. Then install the patch in the folder labeled MarylandFF/media by double clicking on the zipped file that was downloaded. Click "yes" if it asks you if you want to replace the existing file named "POST." The default install is C:\MarylandFF\media. However, your computer may be configured differently (i.e. your hard drive may be labeled D or E, or you may have multiple hard drives). If you download the patch and the highlighting does not change, you may have unzipped it to the wrong place. Find the file named "POST" that you have downloaded and unzipped, and move it to the MarylandFF\media folder where you initially installed the software. Click "yes" if it asks you if you want to replace the existing file named "POST."
